#	Rule	Second?	Debatable?	Vote?	Description				
19.1	Punto de orden				This point must be called when the body is proceeding contrary to the rules, a delegate's integrity is being affected, or when diplomacy is not being objectively appraised.				
19.2	Punto de información				This point must be called whenever a delegate is unsure of the correct proceedings of the committee, use of the rules or any other information regarding the model.				
19.3	Punto de privilegio personal				This point must be used if a delegate's ability to participate in the committee proceedings is impaired. This is the only point that can interrupt a speech at any time.				
19.4	Punto de derecho a réplica				This point should be used for the sole purpose of responding to a formal speech, about false accusations, clarifications, or any other reason why the nation that is calling you was attacked.				
17.1	Re-establish the limits of debate	Sí	1 in favor, 1 against	Super majority	This motion can be used to change the time limits on speeches in the debate.				
17.2	Fromal debate	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	This motion will only apply when the session is in Informal Debate and a return to Formal Debate is required.				
17.3	Informal Debate	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	This motion will suspend formal debate, at which time the chairperson must acknowledge each speaker. The delegate who made the motion must specify the length of debate and the time to speak for each speaker.				
17.4	Consider a draft of resolution	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	After submission of the draft resolution to the members of the floor and after its distribution to the body, this motion allows the body to formally begin substantive debate on the above. If the motion is carried, the sponsors of the resolution will be invited to explain the resolution to the body and to allow time for questions.				
17.5	Change of the order of the agenda	Sí	Can be explained	Super majority	This motion can be used to change the order in which the topics will be discussed.				
17.6	Suspension of the meeting	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	The motion to adjourn the meeting shall apply when a break in the meeting is required, either to work on resolutions or to take a short break from work.				
17.7	Clos debate on a resolution	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	This motion will end the debate on a certain resolution and move the body to the voting procedures. If the motion is carried, the body will vote on the resolution and then continue to debate the issue.				
17.8	Closure of the meeting	Sí	Can be explained	Simple majority	This motion will be accepted when all committee business has been completed, indicating that the committee will not meet again until the next annual meeting.

17.9	Withdrawal of a motion	Yes	Can be explained	No	This motion shall apply when a delegate who has requested a motion feels that his or her motion is no longer necessary.				
17.10	Withdrawal of sponsorship	No	Can be explained	No	This motion shall apply when one of the sponsors of a resolution wishes to withdraw its sponsorship.				
17.11	Withdrawal of a draft resolution	Yes	Can be explained	No	This motion shall apply when the sponsors of a resolution consider that their resolution is no longer relevant to the body.				
17.12	Competence of the committee	Yes	Can be explained	Super majority	This motion will be used to question whether a draft resolution or an amendment is within the scope of the Committee.				
17.13	Appeal the decision of the bureau	Yes	Can be explained	Super majority	This motion will be used in case one of the participants questions the effectiveness of the decision made by the Bureau and wishes to modify such decision.				
17.14	Competence of the bureau	Yes	Can be explained	Super majority	This motion will be used to argue the competence of the Bureau

18.1	Adoption by consensus	No	No	No objection	If there is no objection to the adoption of a proposed resolution by consensus, the proposal shall be adopted by consensus. If there is any objection, the proposal shall be voted on by roll-call.				
18.2	Roll-call vote	No	No	No	This motion will cause the president to name each country, to know their vote. The votes will be: Yes, No, Yes with Rights, No with Rights, Abstention and Abstention from Order.				
18.3	Simple majority	No	No	No	When this motion is called, the Bureau will ask how many delegates are in favor, against and how many abstentions.

24.1	Establishment of the agenda	Yes	No	Super majority	At the beginning of the first session, this motion will be used to establish the nominations of the topics to be discussed.				
24.2	Adding a topic to the agenda	Yes	Can be explained	Super majority	This motion is functional if a new topic needs to be added in addition to the established ones.

26.1	Counter position	Yes	No	No	This motion functions as an admissible rebuttal plea after a participation.				
26.2	Final argument	Yes	No	Simple majority	This motion is intended to reach a resolution directly with the Secretary of Settlement.				
26.3	Testify	Yes	No	Simple majority	This motion will allow the magistrate to call the defendant and the prosecution to ask three questions. This motion may only be used after all 16 entries.
